Lions, tigers, and bears...oh my! It's time to bring your family and friends to the 23rd annual

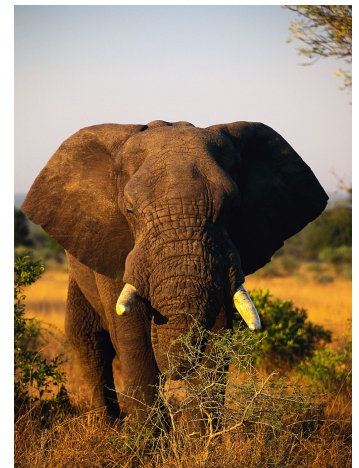
Greater Oregon Safari. Sixty targets, money dots, a raffle, and steak dinner are just some of things to look forward to.

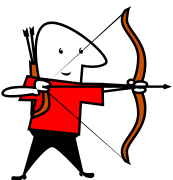
