Let's see you hit "Peanut" our full size elephant at 102 yards!!!(Money Dot!)

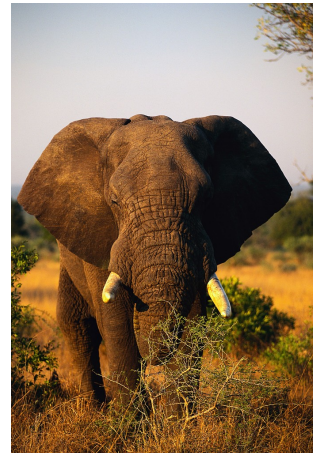
There will also be \$500 guaranteed for the "Money Shoot"

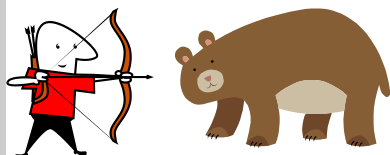
