Adults - \$12 for 1 day or \$18 for 2 days

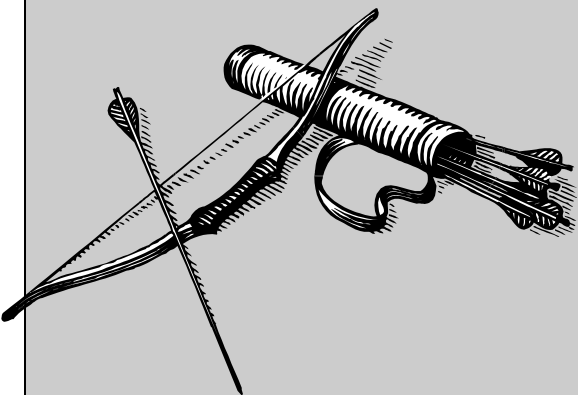
Family - \$25 for 1 day or \$35 for 2 days

Under 11 = free


