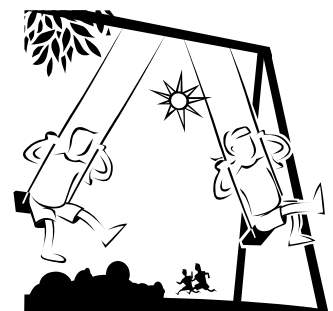
DONATIONS FOR NEW PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT

Talk to a board member if you wish to make a donation to this worthy project.

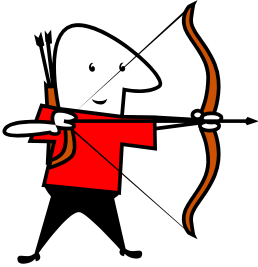




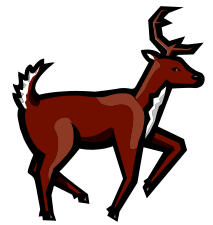
Work party time.
