### Cascadian work party! ( Range Closed )

Cascadian Bowmen Outdoor Range and Clubhouse. May 16th & 17th beginning at 9:00 AM. both days. Below is a list of some of the work to be done. Don't forget gloves.



Elk 15:2 bow racks; Elk 17 :fix step & retaining wall & bow rack; Elk 22 :taller bow rack; Elk 24: bow rack by bench, new bench; Elk 25: fix step, place handrail by target to stop people from walking on bank; fix steps on pink 3D trail.

Deer 4:sign by road needs post, level spot to shoot from at safari; fix steps between D9-D10; Deer 10: pull tip out of bench, clean up trash: Deer 11:pick up old bow rack; Deer 12 bow rack, fix /replace all shooting markers.

Bear 16: fix backstop with 2 4x4's; Bear 26: bow rack

Cougar 1: fix shooting stake; Cougar 2: fix back of bench (needs screws), new post in backboard; Cougar 3: bow rack, new plywood on backboard; Cougar7: bow rack; Cougar 8: new cross arm on bow rack; Cougar 14: new bow rack.
