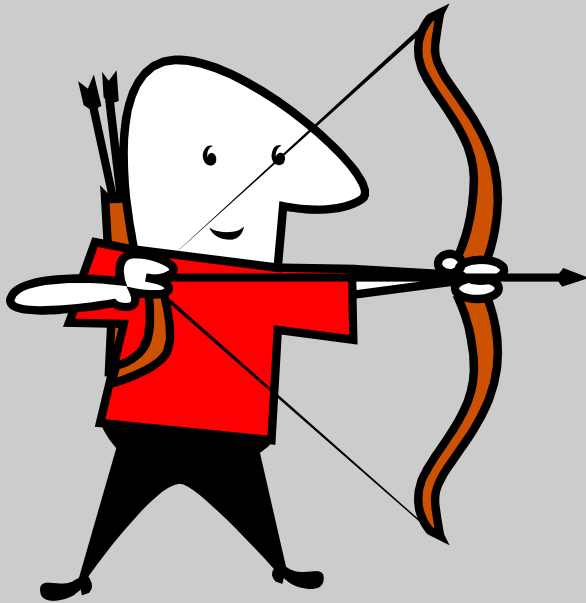




Dec. 4th There is a club meeting / indoor work party at the club's indoor range at 6 PM. Members are always welcome to attend. After the meeting we will be working on targets.
