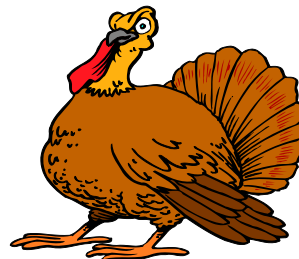
Welcome New Members!

The range will be closed at 3:00 P.M. both days.

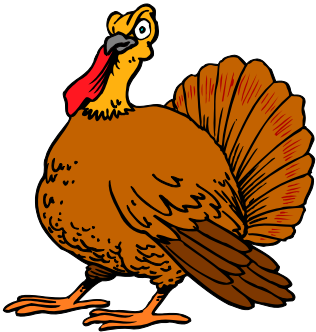
VEGAS TURKEY SHOOT
